FAST PLAY GAME RULES: COIN DROP
GAME #100218**

Tickets for each Fast Play Game shall be made available for sale at the discretion of the Director and shall continue until the Lottery publicly announces a game termination date.

How to win and prize amounts shall be set forth in the rules of the specific game being played.

DEFINITIONS

- (a) **DBG Rules** means the Illinois Department of the Lottery Game Rules, which can be found on the Illinois Lottery website.
- (b) **Fast Play Game** means a draw game with symbols and/or numbers that is terminal-generated, does not require the player to wait for a prescheduled Drawing, and is either sold as a Retail On-Line Game Ticket or an Internet Game Ticket.
- (c) **Validation Number** means the 55-digit number found on the face of the Retail Fast Play Game ticket. The Validation Number shall be printed in black.

Any terms not defined herein shall have the meaning assigned to them in the DBG Rules.

FAST PLAY TICKETS

A Fast Play On-Line Game ticket is a bearer instrument until signed. The player does not have the ability to select his or her own numbers or play symbols. Fast Play Game tickets cannot be cancelled.

TICKET VALIDATION REQUIREMENTS

Determination of winners is subject to Fast Play Game play instructions on the ticket and the following validation requirements. To be a valid ticket, the following requirements must be met:

- (a) The validation data must be present in its entirety; be legible; and correspond, using the computer validation file, to the symbols and/or numbers printed on the ticket for the Drawing date(s) and, if applicable, Drawing time, printed on the ticket;
- (b) The computer symbols and/or numbers, validation data, and, if applicable, the Drawing date(s) and time of an apparent winning ticket must appear on the official file of winning tickets, and a ticket with the exact data must not have been previously paid;
- (c) The symbols and/or numbers must appear and be positioned as indicated in the game briefs executed for the game, and be printed in black ink in their entirety;
- (d) For a Fast Play On-Line Game ticket, the Validation Number must be printed on the face of the ticket and correspond to the game symbols;
- (e) For a Fast Play On-Line Game Ticket, the display printing must be regular in every respect and correspond precisely with the artwork for this game on file at the Lottery;
- (f) The ticket must pass all validation tests of the Lottery; and
- (g) The ticket must pass any additional validation requirements set forth in the DBG Rules.

Any ticket not passing all of the validation tests in this section shall be decreed void and ineligible for any prize and shall not be paid. In the event a defective ticket is purchased, the sole responsibility and/or liability of the Lottery shall be the replacement of the defective ticket with an unplayed ticket(s) of equivalent sales price from any other current Lottery game.

TERMINATION OF THE GAME

The Director, at any time, may announce an end-of-game date for the game. No tickets for this game shall be sold following that date.

RETAILER CONDUCT

Retailers and Retailers' employees are prohibited from placing their own or any other name on any ticket not purchased and redeemed by said agent or employee.

RULES

These Fast Play Game Rules shall be read in conjunction with the DBG Rules. In case of a conflict or contradiction between or among the statutes and rules governing the On-Line Games, but solely with respect to the Fast Play Games, the statutes and rules control in the following order of precedence: 20 ILCS 1605, Lottery Law; Title 11 Illinois Administrative Code Part 1770 Lottery (General), these Fast Play Game Rules, and the DBG Rules.

Appendix A: Price, How to Win and Prize Structure

Illinois Lottery

Fast Play Game: Coin Drop

Price:

Coin Drop lottery tickets sell for \$2.00 per play.

How to Win:

Match YOUR NUMBERS to the numbers in the coins. Connect like prize amounts by creating a path of matched coins from ROWS 1 through to 7 that touch diagonally, to win that amount.

Prize Structure:

The Coin Drop prize structure will be replenished automatically as each ticket is sold in each prize tier, including winning and non-winning prize tiers. The odds remain the same for each ticket purchased for the life of the game. Coin Drop is a set jackpot game with a fixed top prize of \$5,000.
