

## OFFICIAL RULES

### The Pedal to the Metal Sweepstakes

**NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE ODDS OF WINNING.**

**1. PROMOTION PERIOD:** The Pedal to the Metal Sweepstakes (“Promotion”) begins at 8:00 AM Central Time (“CT”) on July 14, 2026 and ends at 11:59 PM CT on August 10, 2026 (“Promotion Period”).

**2. SPONSOR AND ADMINISTRATOR:** For purposes of these Official Rules, “Sponsor” shall mean the Illinois Department of the Lottery, which is acting through Allwyn Illinois LLC (“Administrator”) in its capacity as the private manager or its successor designated by the Sponsor. The Promotion is administered by the Administrator.

**3. AGREEMENT TO THE OFFICIAL RULES:** By participating in the Promotion, all entrants fully and unconditionally agree to and accept these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sponsor and Administrator as final and binding in all matters related to the Promotion. Winning a prize (described below) is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements set forth herein.

**4. HOW TO ENTER:** To enter the Promotion, entrants must log into their account on the official Illinois Lottery application (“Lottery App”) or IllinoisLottery.com. Entrants who do not have a Lottery App or IllinoisLottery.com account must first create an account to log in and enter. After entrants have logged into their Lottery App or IllinoisLottery.com account, they must go to the Illinois Lottery Sweepstakes page (<https://www.illinoislottery.com/sweepstakes>), select the Promotion, read and agree to these Official Rules, then click the “Enter Now” button during the Promotion Period. Afterwards, entrants will receive an automated email, verifying their entrance into the Promotion. Sponsor and the Administrator are not responsible for entries that are incomplete or inaccurate. Limit one (1) entry per person.

The Promotion computer, as determined in Administrator’s sole discretion, is the official timekeeping device for the Promotion. Sponsor, Administrator, and World Wide Technology Raceway (“WWT Raceway”) assume no responsibility for lost, mutilated, late, stolen, or misdirected entries.

**5. ODDS:** Odds of winning the prizes set forth in Section 7 of these Official Rules depends on the total number of eligible entries received during the Promotion Period.

**6. ELIGIBILITY:** The Promotion is open only to individuals who, at the time of entry, are at least eighteen (18) years of age and are residents of the State of Illinois. In addition, the following persons are not eligible to enter this Promotion or claim a prize: (a) the employees, officers, directors, partners, equity holders, members and agents of the Administrator or WWT Raceway (b) any member of the Lottery Control Board (“Board”), and any officer or any other person employed by the Board or the Sponsor; (c) the employees, officers, directors, partners, equity

holders, and members of the National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing ( “NASCAR”); (d) officers and employees of advertising, public relations, and sales promotion agencies employed by the Sponsor or Administrator who are directly involved in the Illinois Lottery engagement; (e) officers and employees of audit firms performing services for the Sponsor; (f) other contractors and agents of the Sponsor; and (g) any spouse, child, or family member residing as a member of the same households in the principal place of residence of any person designated in (a) through (f). This Promotion is void where prohibited by law.

## **7. PRIZES AND THE VALUE OF THE PRIZES:**

**One (1) Experience Prize:** The Experience Prize winner will receive four (4) tickets, one (1) for the winner and three (3) for their guests, for the Enjoy Illinois 300 NASCAR Cup Series race at WWT Raceway on September 13, 2026 (“Race”) (seat locations shall be determined in the sole discretion of WWT Raceway); four (4) passes to the driver’s meeting held prior to the Race; four (4) pace car rides the morning of the Race; one (1) VIP parking pass; four (4) hats; four (4) t-shirts; and four (4) \$50 food vouchers for use at select locations and concession stands, which shall be identified on such vouchers (collectively, the “Experience Prize”). The approximate retail value (“ARV”) of the Experience Prize is \$5,890.00.

**One (1) Ticket Prize:** The Ticket Prize winner will receive two (2) tickets, one for the winner and one (1) for their guest, for the Race (seat locations shall be determined in the sole discretion of WWT Raceway); and one (1) VIP parking pass (collectively, the “Ticket Prize”). The ARV of the Ticket Prize is \$250.00.

The Experience Prize and Ticket Prize may be referred to herein collectively as the “Prizes.” The Experience Prize Winners, and Ticket Prize Winner, may be referred to herein collectively as the “Winners.”

The dates and times of the Promotion may be subject to change and cancellation. The Winners and guest(s) agree to comply with all applicable venue rules and policies in connection with the prizes. Any comments made by a Winner in a social media format containing material that is inappropriate, offensive, indecent, obscene, hateful, tortious, defamatory, slanderous, or libelous may disqualify the winner, at Administrator’s sole discretion. The Released Parties (defined below) will not be responsible for acts of God, acts of terrorism, civil disturbances, work stoppage, or any other natural disaster outside their control that may cause the cancellation or postponement of the Promotion. All other expenses and costs, not expressly listed above, including, but not limited to, federal, state, and local taxes, parking, and ground transportation are the Winners’ sole responsibility. All travel risks, insurance, loss, or damage due to Prize acceptance or use are the sole responsibility of the Winners. The Released Parties will not be responsible for any loss, liability, or damage arising out of a Winner’s acceptance or use of a Prize or element thereof. The Prizes are not exchangeable or otherwise transferable.

**8. WINNER SELECTION AND NOTIFICATION TO PRIZE WINNER(S):** The Administrator will conduct a drawing to randomly select two (2) potential Winners from the pool of eligible entries received during the Promotion Period on or around August 11, 2026. The first

potential Winner selected will be deemed the Experience Prize Winner, and the second potential Winner will be deemed the Ticket Prize Winner. The Administrator will contact the potential Winners on or around August 12, 2026 (“Sweepstakes Notification Date”) and provide instructions on how to claim the Prize (“Prize Notification”). The Prize Notification will be sent to the email address provided in the potential winner’s Lottery App or IllinoisLottery.com account. The potential Winners will be required to execute and return the Promotion prize claim form (either in person or via email) and release of liability and publicity, unless prohibited by law. The potential Winners will have the length of time set forth in the Promotion prize claim form to claim their prize. Sponsor shall determine if the potential Experience Prize Winner has an outstanding debt to the State of Illinois or any city or county within Illinois, owe delinquent taxes, or are past due on child support. If any debt is discovered, the potential Experience Prize Winner will be disqualified. The Administrator will notify such potential Winners of their disqualification.

The Administrator or Administrator’s designee will send the Race ticket portion of the Prize(s) to the email address provided in each qualified Winner’s Lottery App or IllinoisLottery.com account via Metrotix or similar digital means. The VIP parking portion of the Prizes will also be sent by the Administrator or Administrator’s designee to the qualified Winners via overnight courier (e.g., FedEx), requiring a signature upon request. The WWT Raceway, Administrator, and/or Administrator’s designee will provide the qualified Winners the remaining portions of the Prizes (i.e., pace car rides, passes to driver’s meeting, merchandise, and food vouchers) at the Race. By entering, the entrant consents to be contacted by the Administrator, Administrator’s designee, WWT Raceway, and/or Sponsor in connection with the Prize Notification. The Sponsor, Administrator, and Administrator’s designee will not be liable for any delays in the receipt of Prize Notification messages.

If any potential Winner does not respond to the Prize Notification within the time period set forth in the Promotion prize claim form or declines the prize for any reason, disqualification and prize forfeiture will result, and at Administrator’s sole discretion and time permitting, an alternate potential Winner will be randomly selected from the pool of eligible entries received during the Promotion Period.

The potential Winners is subject to verification of identity and eligibility prior to the award of the Prize.

**9. GENERAL PRIZE RESTRICTIONS:** Prizes are subject to availability and change. Only one (1) Prize per household will be allowed during the Promotion Period. If due to a printing, production or other error more Prizes are claimed than are intended to be awarded, the intended Prize or Prizes will be awarded in a random drawing from among all verified and validated entries. All Prizes won by Winners will be subject to the Sponsor’s debt setoff procedures. No cash equivalent of the Prizes will be awarded, and the Prizes are not exchangeable or otherwise transferable. The Sponsor and Administrator reserve the right to substitute any Prize in whole or in part with other Prizes of comparable or greater value, if the intended Prize is not available for any reason, as determined by the Sponsor and Administrator, in their sole discretion. Transportation, and lodging are not included. The Winners will be exclusively and solely responsible for travel to and the costs thereof, and all other costs and expenses associated with

Prize acceptance and use not described as being provided, including but not limited to parking expenses, gratuities, incidentals, and other expenses incurred by accepting any Prize. This Promotion is governed by and shall be construed in accordance with Illinois law and is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations. Any and all taxes, including but not limited to federal, state, and local taxes, are the exclusive and sole responsibility of the Winners. The Winners may be required to provide their Social Security number and appropriate tax documentation for tax reporting purposes. If required, Sponsor or Administrator will file an IRS Form 1099 or similar document with the Internal Revenue Service for the fair market value of any prize.

**10. GENERAL CONDITIONS AND RELEASE:** The Promotion is subject to applicable laws and regulations. By entering, each entrant (a) agrees to defend, indemnify, release, and hold harmless the Sponsor, WWT Raceway, NASCAR, and the Administrator (collectively, the “Promotion Entities”), and each of their respective owners, parents, affiliates, subsidiaries, directors, officers, agents, employees, managers, licensees, distributors, dealers, retailers, printers, representatives, advertising and promotion agencies, and any and all other companies associated with the Promotion, and all of their respective officers, directors, employees, agents, and representatives (collectively with the Promotion Entities, the “Released Parties”) from and against any and all claims, causes, costs, injuries, losses, or damages of any kind that may occur, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, arising out of the entrant’s participation in this Promotion or receipt or use of any prizes, including, but not limited to: (i) unauthorized human intervention in the Promotion; (ii) technical errors related to computers, servers, providers, or telephone or network lines; (iii) printing errors; (iv) lost, late, postage-due, misdirected, or undeliverable mail; (v) errors in the administration of the Promotion or the processing of entries, including but not limited to data entry errors resulting from or caused by the entering, keying, or mis-keying of the required information by entrants; (vi) injury or damage to persons or property that may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from entrant’s participation in the Promotion or receipt or use of any prize; (vii) the unauthorized or illegal access to personally identifiable or sensitive information or the acceptance, possession, use, or misuse of any prize or any travel or activity related to the receipt or use of any prize; (b) if selected as the winner, consents to the use by Sponsor, Administrator, and each of their respective designees of the winner’s name, hometown, photograph, voice, or other likenesses and prize information for promotion, advertising, and marketing purposes in any media or format now known or hereafter devised, throughout the world, in perpetuity, without additional compensation, consideration, notification, or permission, unless prohibited by law, and upon request will provide written confirmation of such consent; and (c) acknowledges that none of the Released Parties or anyone else has either made, or is in any manner responsible or liable for, any warranty, representation, or guarantee, either expressed or implied, in fact or in law, relative to any prize including but not limited to, its quality or availability and ALL SUCH WARRANTIES ARE DISCLAIMED IN THEIR ENTIRETY.

None of the Released Parties or any of their service providers are responsible for incorrect or inaccurate transcription of entry information; any human or other error, technical malfunctions; lost or delayed data or voice transmission; omission; interruption; deletion; defect; line failures of any telephone network, computer equipment, or software; inability to access any online service or website or to complete a telephone call or facsimile transaction; any other error or malfunction; late, lost, or misdirected mail; or any injury or damage to an entrant’s or any other person’s

computer related to or resulting from participation in this Promotion.

None of the Released Parties are responsible for or liable for: (a) late, lost, damaged, misdirected, misaddressed, incomplete, unintelligible, illegible, or postage due entries; (b) telephone, electronic, hardware or software program, network, internet or computer malfunctions, failures or difficulties of any kind; (c) failed, incomplete, garbled, or delayed computer transmissions; (d) any condition caused by events beyond their control that may cause the Promotion to be disrupted or corrupted; (e) any injuries, losses, or damages of any kind arising in connection with or as a result of the Promotion, acceptance, possession, or from participation in the Promotion; (f) any printing or typographical error in any material associated with the Promotion; (g) any other errors, problems or difficulties of any kind whether human, mechanical, electronic, network, computer, telephone, wireless service, mail, typographical, printing or otherwise relating to or in connection with the Promotion, including, without limitation, errors or difficulties that may occur in connection with the administration of the Promotion, the processing of entries, the announcement of the prizes, or in any Promotion-related materials, or the cancellation or postponement of any Major League Baseball event or exhibition; or (h) any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by website users, tampering, hacking, or by any equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Promotion.

Sponsor and Administrator reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to cancel the Promotion in its entirety, if it becomes technically corrupted or because of non-authorized human intervention. If any discrepancy should exist between these Official Rules and any promotional material describing this Promotion, these Official Rules shall govern.

**CAUTION:** ANY ATTEMPT BY AN ENTRANT OR ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL TO DAMAGE ANY WEBSITE ASSOCIATED WITH THIS PROMOTION, TAMPER WITH THE ENTRY PROCESS, OR OTHERWISE UNDERMINE THE CONTENT OR LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE PROMOTION MAY BE A VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND CIVIL LAWS AND SHOULD SUCH AN ATTEMPT BE MADE, ADMINISTRATOR WILL DISQUALIFY ANY SUCH ENTRANT, AND ADMINISTRATOR AND THE APPLICABLE PROMOTION ENTITIES AND THEIR RESPECTIVE AGENTS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO SEEK DAMAGES (INCLUDING ATTORNEYS' FEES) AND OTHER REMEDIES FROM ANY SUCH ENTRANT OR INDIVIDUAL(S) RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ATTEMPT TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW.

No failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall constitute a waiver of that provision. These Official Rules may be modified for clarification purposes without materially affecting the terms and conditions of the Promotion. If for any reason the Promotion (or any portion thereof) is not capable of being executed as planned, or in the case of infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, action of entrants, technical failures, or any other causes that, in the opinion of Sponsor or Administrator, corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of this Promotion (or any portion thereof), Sponsor and Administrator reserve the right in their sole discretion to disqualify any suspect entry or entrant and/or to cancel, terminate, modify, or suspend the Promotion (or any portion thereof). Any entrant that enters the Promotion via a fake account (e.g., bot account) will be disqualified. In the event of any disqualification of a suspect entry or entrant, notice thereof will be posted and

the determination of the prize winner will be made from among all eligible, non-suspect entries received as of the time of such disqualification, as Sponsor or Administrator determine in their sole discretion. Entrants not complying with all rules are subject to disqualification. In the event of any termination, cancellation, or suspension, notice thereof will be posted on the Sponsor's website.

**11. APPLICABLE LAWS:** All entrants agree to comply with and abide by all applicable laws, including the Illinois Lottery Law (20 ILCS 1605/1 *et seq.*), administrative rules and regulations, instructions, conditions and final decisions of the Sponsor and all procedures established by Sponsor and the Administrator for the Promotion. In the event of a conflict between these Official Rules and any summary, representation, or other restatement of rules appearing in any advertisement, point of sale material, tickets or other media, these Official Rules shall govern. In the case of a conflict or contradiction between or among the Illinois Lottery Law, Illinois Lottery administrative rules (11 Ill. Admin. Code Parts 1700 and 1770), and these Official Rules, the Illinois Lottery Law and administrative rules shall control. The Sponsor does not waive sovereign immunity rights provided under law and nothing in these Official Rules shall be interpreted to constitute a waiver of the Sponsor's sovereign immunity rights.

**12. DISPUTE RESOLUTION:** Except where prohibited by law, by entering, Promotion entrants agree that in the event of a dispute concerning the construction, validity, interpretation, or enforceability of these Official Rules, the determination of the Sponsor shall be final and binding. Any entrant who disputes a final decision of the Sponsor may seek review before an Administrative Law Judge pursuant to Section 7.3 of the Illinois Lottery Law. In accordance with the Illinois Lottery's hearing rules (11 Ill. Admin. Code Part 1700), the Director will review the recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge and, if applicable, the Board, and issue a final decision regarding the dispute. Any party adversely affected by a final decision or order of the Director may obtain judicial review as provided by the Illinois Lottery's hearing rules and Administrative Review Law (735 ILCS 5/Article III). All issues and questions concerning the rights and obligations of participant(s) in relation to Sponsor, Administrator, and their agents shall be governed by and construed exclusively in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois without giving effect to any principles of conflicts of law of any jurisdiction. Entrant agrees that any such action at law or in equity shall be filed only in the state or federal courts located in Chicago, Illinois, and entrant hereby consents and submits to the personal jurisdiction of such courts for the purposes of litigating any such action. EXCEPT WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW, BY PARTICIPATING IN THIS PROMOTION, EACH ENTRANT AGREES THAT: (A) ANY AND ALL DISPUTES, CLAIMS, AND CAUSES OF ACTION ARISING OUT OF OR CONNECTED WITH THIS PROMOTION, OR AWARDING OF THE PRIZES, SHALL BE RESOLVED INDIVIDUALLY, WITHOUT RESORT TO ANY FORM OF CLASS ACTION; AND (B) ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, JUDGMENTS, AND AWARDS SHALL BE LIMITED TO ACTUAL OUT-OF-POCKET COSTS INCURRED, INCLUDING COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH PARTICIPATING IN THIS PROMOTION BUT IN NO EVENT ATTORNEYS' FEES; AND (C) UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL ANY PARTICIPANT BE PERMITTED TO OBTAIN AWARDS FOR AND HEREBY WAIVES ALL RIGHTS TO CLAIM PUNITIVE, INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, MULTIPLIED OR OTHERWISE INCREASED DAMAGES; AND ANY OTHER DAMAGES, OTHER THAN FOR ACTUAL OUT-OF-POCKET EXPENSES.

**13. E-MAIL COMMUNICATION:** By entering this Promotion, entrants will automatically be signed up to receive e-mail communication from the Illinois Lottery. Entrants will have the ability to unsubscribe from these e-mails upon receipt.
