Pay in-store, win at home

If your customers purchase an instant ticket during their shopping trip, suggest they pay in-store and win at home. Instant games should be scratched at home - players can check tickets for all games via the ticket scanner on the mobile app. In-store signage for your store supports:

- Pay in-store, win at home
- Health reminders: 6-foot distance and avoid touching the face.

Safety Reminder

We encourage retailers and all employees when handling tickets, play slips, or money to treat these as they do all other items in-store. This means following approved safety measures from the CDC, such as regularly washing hands with soap and water for 20 seconds at a time.
