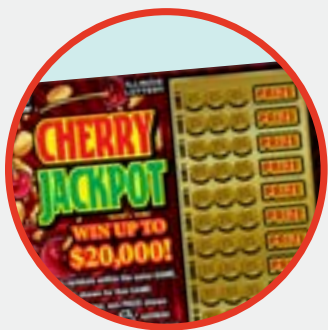

Accessible Restrooms, Fitting Rooms, and Elevators

An important area that enhances the customer experience is the ability to move comfortably within the establishment. Maintenance of accessible restrooms, customer service and product demonstration areas, and lifts and elevators is essential for all customers to fully enjoy the shopping experience and buy merchandise. Unlock accessible public restrooms, toilet stalls, and fitting rooms and make sure they are available to customers with disabilities during business hours. They cannot be used as temporary storage areas or staff locker space.

Eliminate furniture or equipment, such as shelving, large trash cans, and chairs that take up required maneuvering space in fitting rooms and restrooms. Routinely refill the accessible paper towel and soap dispensers when all other dispensers are refilled. Maintain lifts and elevators regularly. Repair them whenever necessary, and return them to service as quickly as possible. Remove trash receptacles and other obstructions from under elevator call buttons and beside doors to ensure access to controls and sufficient maneuvering clearance.

BEST PRACTICES

Damaged Ticket Procedure (Printer Jam)

We've all been there...experiencing technical difficulties. Here are some tips on how to fix a paper jam and get credit for a damaged ticket:

- Clear paper jam and close printer cover
- A serial number will display on the screen
- Write the serial number down on the damaged ticket
- Go to **Reprints** and select **Last Wager**

- Select **Total Screen** and **Print**
- Mail all 3 items (damaged ticket, serial number, and reprint) to the following address:

To avoid potential paper jams, please change the roll in the printer when you see the black line; don't wait until the paper runs out. If the printer runs completely out of paper, the terminal will *not* allow you to sign in until a new roll is inserted.
